Anderson School Standing Committees

Negotiations Warren and Jaime

Description: The negotiations committee meets as needed each year to work with the business manager, Superintendent, and staff on the CBA for certified staff. Typically this occurs February-June Each year.

Maintenance/Facilities/Safety

(Includes Short and Long Range Facility Planning) Jack and Brandon

Description: The facilities committee generally meets 1-2 times per year and includes a building walkthrough in late summer. Other meetings of the committee might include long-range planning discussions or events.

Technology Warren and Jack

Description: The technology committee generally meets 2-3 times per year and includes a spring planning session to review needs, budget, and purchasing.

Curriculum Jaime and Mary

Description: The staff has an RtI committee that meets monthly throughout the school year. This committee routinely reviews and assesses curriculum, assessment, and instructional strategies. At least once per year (most commonly spring/summer) the RtI committee will meet with the Board committee to discuss curriculum and current data trends.

Wellness Jack and Jaime

Description: The staff has a Wellness committee that meets 2-3 times throughout the school year. At least once per year (as required by Montana Law) the full committee (including Board members) will meet to review the policy and address other current topics or agenda items.
