

Resolution of Intent to Impose and Increase in Non-Voted Levies – HB 307 Anderson School District #41

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Anderson School District #41 Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Board of Trustees estimates the following increases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school year beginning July 1, 2021, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:

Fund Supported

Transportation

Estimated Changes-revenue, \$3,254 increase

Estimated Changes-mills, 0.70 mill increase

Estimated impact on Home w/market value of \$100K, \$0.95 annual increase

Estimated impact on home w/market value of \$200K, \$1.90 annual increase

Bus Depreciation

Estimated Changes-revenue, \$1,063 increase

Estimated Changes-mills, 0.23 mill increase

Estimated impact on Home w/market value of \$100K, \$0.31 annual increase

Estimated impact on home w/market value of \$200K, .62 annual increase

Tuition

Estimated Changes-revenue, \$10,000 increase

Estimated Changes-mills, 2.15 mill increase

Estimated impact on Home w/market value of \$100K, \$2.90 annual increase

Estimated impact on home w/market value of \$200K, \$5.80 annual increase

Total Change of All Funds

Increase in revenues: \$14,317

Increase in mills: 3.08

These estimates are preliminary and changes are expected before the final budgets are set in August.
