Federal Chronic Absenteeism

To be considered Federally Chronically absent a student must miss 10% of school days. So for our calendar that is 18 days. Yes, this statistic has an asterisk this year due to COVID and students being out due to quarantine. However, we still had many students miss school for family vacations and other commitments. If a child is not in school it makes it incredibly difficult for them to receive appropriate instruction plus puts stress on our staff to make up lost instructional time.



Difference in Purpose between FastBridge and SBAC

Assessment is a process of collecting information to guide instruction. FastBridge is a platform used to screen all students in grades K-8 three times a year. Our MTSS system is designed to use this benchmark/screening data to determine if a student is at risk for not meeting grade-level expectations. The data also helps us determine if further diagnostic assessments are needed to provide targeted instruction to specific skills. This guides our tier 1 core instruction, which is our first form of intervention.

Smarter Balanced is a summative statewide assessment used to assess students in grades 3-8 on all skills in ELA, Math and Science. This form of assessment is done in the spring after instruction has occurred.

SBAC Testing Data 2022

Approximately 99% of students in Grades 3-8 took the Smarter Balanced Assessment in the spring of 2022. The Smarter Balanced Test has an ELA computer adaptive test with short written answers, a Math computer adaptive test, and a Math performance task. Fifth and eighth graders also took the state science assessment, but results will not be available until Fall of 2022 due to standards settings which will occur this summer.
